Only available to Military Personnel on Active Duty (Includes Reserves and Title 10 National Guard)

- Advocate provides supportive services
- Medical care and counseling offered
- NO investigation started
- Option to Change Restricted to Unrestricted at later date

Unrestricted Reporting

Available to all military, DOD Civilians and ADULT Family Members

- Advocates provides supportive services
- Medical care available
- Counseling offered
- Chain of Command involved
- Investigation initiated



He responded, "Being an advocate has opened the harsh reality that horrible things do happen in real life and its nothing like Hollywood has made it out to be. The victim of this type of crime doesn't go out and seek their revenge on the attacker. The attacker most of the time isn't a stranger, 95% of the time it's someone they knew. I now know that sexual harassment and assault isn't a good twist or event in a movie it is a real life changing event that does cause damage that is felt everyday and not just to the victim, but also to the friends, co-workers, and family members."
