CMSgt Davann Irons is the Senior Enlisted Leader, Altus Medical Group, Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma. She is the personal advisor to the medical group commander and executive staff on matters concerning the welfare, effective use, training, career progression and organizational performance of 170 personnel assigned. She communicates concerns and issues of the enlisted force to the commander and ensures the commander's policies enforced. As a member of the executive staff, she participates in all phases of strategic planning, resourcing and implementation by providing safe and reliable healthcare to more than 11,600 Department of Defense beneficiaries to include 2,000 KC-46 Pegasus, C-17 Globemaster III, and KC-135 Stratotanker Total Force aircrew students annually with a \$7.6M budget across two squadrons.
