CMSgt Crystal M. Jarvis serves as the Senior Enlisted Leader, 97th Medical Group, Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma. She is the personal advisor to the medical group commander and executive staff on matters concerning the welfare, effective use, training, career progression and organizational performance of 170 personnel assigned. She communicates concerns and issues of the enlisted force to the commander and ensures the commander's policies are known and understood by all enlisted personnel. She is the group leader for maintaining discipline and standards regarding quality force issues. As a member of the executive staff she participates in all phases of strategic planning, resourcing and implementation of the group's operational plan to provide healthcare for patients.

Chief Jarvis enlisted in the Air Force January of 1998. After completing the Dental Assistant Apprentice Course at Sheppard Air Force Base in Texas, Chief Jarvis performed in a variety of different positions and settings for the dental career field. In 2006 she was selected for the Air Force Dental Hygiene Scholarship Training Program, and began training at St. Petersburg College in St. Petersburg, Florida. In 2008, she graduated from the program with an Associate in Science, Dental Hygiene degree and was awarded her license in the state of Florida. She also served as the Air Force Dental Hygiene Consultant to the Surgeon General from July 2012 to January 2015.



Prior to assuming her current position, she was one of two Dental Major Command Functional Managers as well as the Senior Enlisted Leader for Air Force Dental Services, Operational Clinical Dentistry Department headed by the Air Force Medical Readiness Agency. Her assignments include bases in Guam, Germany, Florida, Missouri, Texas, and Virginia.
