Winter Weather Preparedness

Tips for the Winter



- Dress warm, in several layers of clothing.
- Wear waterproof, insulated boots.
- Minimize travel, if necessary, and keep a disaster kit in your car.
- Local news channels can provide critical information.
- Keep vehicle tank full to keep fuel line from freezing.
- Bring pets inside during winter weather.
- Keep small amounts of house hold water running to prevent water pipes from freezing.
- Have a family emergency plan.

Winter Vehicle Preparation

In case of an emergency, everyone should carry a winter survival kit in their vehicle. Here is a list of a few items that would be beneficial to have in your kit:
