

MOSQUITO FOGGING ANNOUNCEMENT

The 97 CES Pest Management shop will fog for mosquitoes from 9 June to approximately 27 July, on an as needed basis. Fogging operations will take place on an as needed basis Monday through Friday between the hours of 0300-0600 and 1900-2200. Limit outside movement during the times scheduled for fogging.

CAUTION: The pesticide used to fog for mosquitoes is harmful if absorbed through the skin or ingested. If it gets in your eyes it can cause temporary eye irritation. Prevent these problems by avoiding contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. In case of contact, flush area with plenty of water. Wash/shower thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If pesticide gets in eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. If present, remove contact lenses. If necessary contact the Poison Control Center at (800) 222-1222 for further information.



If you see this vehicle or a green Gator (utility vehicle) in the evening, night, or in the early morning hours and there is a mist coming from green nozzle in the back take the following precautions:

If you are in a vehicle and you must go the direction the fogging truck is moving roll up your windows, turn on your air conditioner, and make sure it is on recirculate.

If you are driving in an open vehicle with no top such as a jeep or convertible, **DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH THE FOG! DO NOT FOLLOW THE TRUCK!** If possible find a different route or stop your vehicle, find a parking spot, and wait for the fog to leave the area.

If you are on a motorcycle or bicycle **DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH THE FOG! DO NOT FOLLOW THE TRUCK!** If possible find a different route or stop your motorcycle or bicycle, find a parking spot, and wait for the fog to leave the area.

If you are out walking or jogging **DO NOT WALK OR JOG THROUGH THE FOG.** If possible find another route or go back into the nearest building and wait for the fog to leave the area.

If you are outside taking a smoke break and you see the vehicle above fogging in your area stop smoking and go inside the nearest building immediately. You can resume your smoke break in about 30 to 45 minutes. Pesticide fumes can enter the smoker's lungs system through the cigarette while they are smoking.

Base personnel who are pregnant should stay away from the pesticide at all times. If they must work they should report to duty before fogging operations begin and are not allowed outside until 1 hour after fogging operations have been completed, a schedule with dates and times will be published to inform base personnel about fogging operations.
