

At the camp, we will educate youth from our eight-county region about substance abuse prevention strategies as well as how to create a work plan for their specific school or community for the 2011-2012 school year. We will also work on teambuilding exercises, including a day at the ropes course. This is a free event, and anyone ages 12-17 who is interested in youth leadership and substance abuse prevention may apply. Representatives from various counties will be selected.

The camp will take place on April 29-May 1 at Cross Point in Kingston. Applications are due on April 20, and those selected will receive a confirmation packet the following week. This is a great opportunity for youth leaders who wish to network with their peers in southern Oklahoma while also learning more about prevention in their own communities.
