

Stormwater

As part of our commitment to environmental stewardship, AAFB has developed and implemented a comprehensive Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). This plan establishes a framework of procedures and practices to prevent pollution and protect the quality of local water resources, including Stinking Creek and its tributaries. The SWPPP ensures that all base operations comply with federal, state, and local environmental regulations, including the Clean Water Act and the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) requirements.

The SWPPP identifies all industrial activities at AAFB that could potentially impact stormwater, such as aircraft and vehicle maintenance, fueling operations, and material storage. To mitigate these risks, the base employs a wide range of Best Management Practices (BMPs). These measures include structural controls like oil-water separators and containment facilities, alongside procedural controls such as comprehensive employee training, stringent good housekeeping, regular inspections, and established spill prevention and response protocols. Through diligent implementation of this plan, Altus Air Force Base is dedicated to minimizing its environmental footprint and preserving the health of our local watershed.
